PROPOSED UPGRADING OF THREE ROADS, WARD 59: MOSCOW COMMUNITY, PHOENIX, ETHEKWINI METROPOLITAN, KWAZULU-NATAL

Terratest (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Nankhoo Engineers (Pty) Ltd, on behalf of the EThekweni Metropolitan, to undertake the environmental services required for the proposed upgrading of three existing gravel roads located within Ward 59: Moscow Community, Phoenix, EThekweni Metropolitan, KwaZulu-Natal. The Moscow Community consists largely of informal and semi-rural settlements. Very little formal infrastructure exists to provide basic services to the community. The existing gravel roads vary in length from 230m – 590m. All existing gravel roads cross watercourses.

The upgrading of the roads is part of a larger project being undertaken by the EThekweni Metropolitan whereby multiple, existing gravel roads in various wards of the Metropolitan are being formally upgraded. Several of the roads initially identified by the EThekweni Metropolitan for upgrading do not require Environmental Authorisation prior to construction, as they do not trigger any of the Listed Activities as noted in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014). An Environmental Management Programme (EMPr), specific to each road, has however been drafted, submitted and approved by the EThekweni Metropolitan's Environmental Planning and Climate Protection Department, prior to construction commencing.

In terms of this Application, three roads have been identified which require Environmental Authorisation prior to upgrading as their respective alignments cross watercourses. In accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) and the EIA Regulations (2014), the following Listed Activities are triggered given that each road will intercept at least one watercourse:

- GNR 982 – Item 12: *“The development of (iii) bridges exceeding 100m² in size; (vi) bulk storm water outlet structures exceeding 100m² in size; (xii) infrastructure or structures with a physical footprint of 100m² or more; where such development occurs (a) within a watercourse; (b) in front of the development setback; or (c) if no development setback exists, within 32 metres of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse; excluding (dd) where such development occurs within an urban area; or (ee) where such development occurs within existing roads or road reserves.”*
 - Watercourses are present on site which bisect Roads 1, 2 & 3. The existing gravel crossings are informal and will require upgrading.
- GNR 983 - Item 19: *“The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 5 cubic metres from (i) a watercourse.”*
 - Watercourses are present on site which bisect Roads 1, 2 & 3. The existing gravel crossings are informal and will require upgrading, which will necessitate the movement of 5m³ or more into or from a watercourse.

- GNR 983 - Item 48: *“The expansion of (iii) bridges where the bridge is expanded by 100m² or more in size; bulk storm water outlet structures where the bulk storm water outlet structure is expanded by 100m² or more in size where such expansion or expansion and related operation occurs (a) within a watercourse; (c) if no development setback exists, within 32 metres of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse excluding (dd) where such development occurs within an urban area; or (ee) where such development occurs within existing roads or road reserves.”*
 - Watercourses are present on site which bisect Roads 1, 2, & 3. The crossings are informal and will require upgrading.

- GNR 983 - Item 49: *“The expansion of (v) infrastructure or structures where the physical footprint is expanded by 100m² or more; where such expansion or expansion and related operation occurs (a) within a watercourse; (c) if no development setback exists, within 32 metres of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse excluding (dd) where such development occurs within an urban area; or (ee) where such development occurs within existing roads or road reserves.”*
 - Watercourses are present on site which bisect Roads 1, 2, & 3. The crossings are informal and will require upgrading.

The proposed upgrade will consist of blacktop surfacing three existing gravel roads in Ward 59, EThekwini Metropolitan. The proposed roads will be surfaced to a 3 – 3.5 metre blacktop deck with formalised stormwater drainage and management systems being installed where necessary. The location and length of the proposed upgrades are noted in Table 1. A Locality Map is provided as Appendix 1.

Site Map

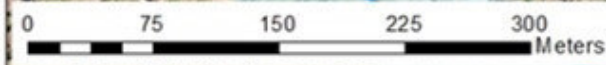
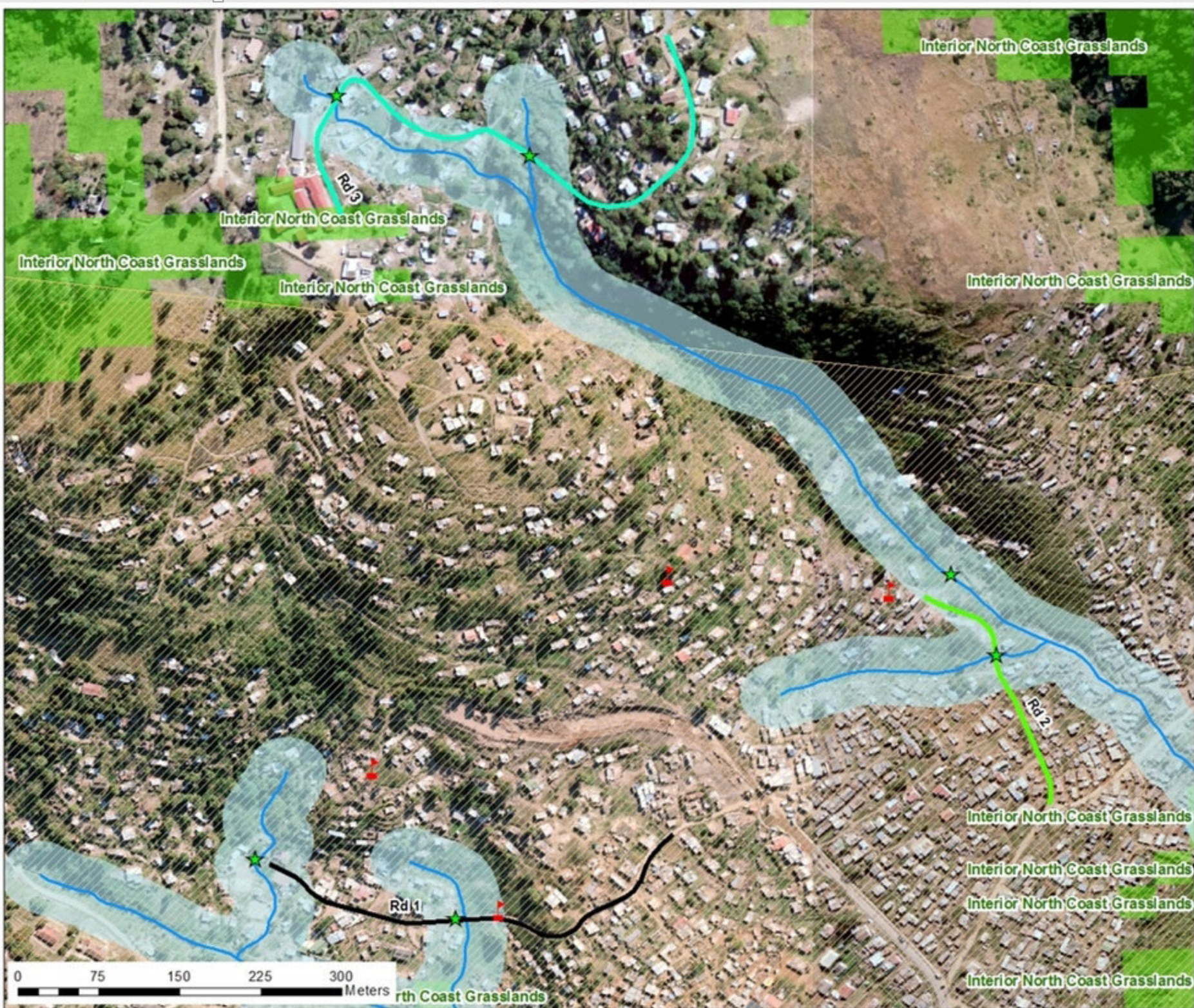
