In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and the KwaZulu-Natal Heritage Act (Act 4 of 2008)

Bulk water pipeline from Umbulwane to Lombard's Kop, Ladysmith, KwaZulu-Natal

We acknowledge receipt of your invitation for the Provincial Heritage Resources Authority Section 38(1) decision in terms of the National heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 with regards to the proposed development. The survey by Gavin Anderson of Umlando recorded several heritage sites that include Late Iron Age stone walled settlements, 2nd Anglo-Boer War fortifications, hospitals and graves, and more recent human graves along the pipeline route. Since the pipeline route will traverse sensitive zones as indicated by the HIA Practitioner, a watching brief/monitoring programme should be implemented while a Phase 1 palaeontological survey will be required for some areas of the pipeline route where the new pipes will be placed.

The final routing and planning must be confirmed with an archaeologist and Amafa KZN prior to construction activities and site clearance. Due to the sensitivity of the proposed area of operation, an archaeologist must therefore be appointed to monitor site clearance and construction activities. A monitoring plan should be submitted to Amafa prior to commencement of work. A buffer zone of 25m should be delineated around the heritage resources. The construction team should undergo an induction programme prior to construction and site clearance.

The South African Heritage Resources legislation stipulates that no heritage resources should be destroyed, disturbed, excavated, damaged, altered, exhumed, relocated without a permit from Amafa. Should the developer consider any intrusive work in and around the heritage resources, a permit application should be lodged with Amafa. Criminal charges will be instituted against any transgressors.

In view of the findings outlined in the HIA Report by Gavin Anderson of Umlando that we received for the above proposed development, we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended

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without a permit from Amafa.

3. No activities are allowed within 50m of a site, which contains rock art.
4. Sources of all natural materials (including topsoil, sands, natural gravels, crushed stone, asphalt, etc.) must be obtained in a sustainable manner and in compliance with the heritage legislation.
